WORKSHOPS



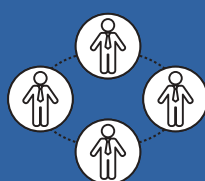

These workshops focused on Adult Learning, Action Learning, Coaching Skills, Facilitation Skills Using Experiential Learning and Conducting Learning Needs Assessments.
